# a key to our apostle's symbols tiles

Christ: PX; Peter: upside-down cross method of martyrdom with crossed keys from Matthew 16; James: vertical cross-hilted sword and scallop, signifying pilgrimage and martyrdom; John: chalice and serpent...spared by God from drinking from a poison-laced cup; Andrew: the X shaped cross of his martyrdom; Matthew: the money purses as he was a tax collector originally; Philip: the loaves from the miracle where Philip remarked in John 6; Bartholomew: the knives representing his martyrdom of being flayed alive and then crucified; Thomas: carpenter's square for his personally building the Church in India and a spear for his martyrdom by a pagan priest; James the Less: the stones represent his stoning in Jerusalem and the saw for his body being sawn asunder; Jude: a sailing boat with cross mast, for his innumerable sea journeys in preaching the Gospel; Simon: companion of Jude, with a book and fish, as he was a great fisher of men; Matthias: the battle axe and two stones represent the martyrdom of being stoned and then beheaded.
