The Church upholds that if you are divorced civilly, and not remarried, you may still receive Holy Communion and the sacraments. If you are remarried or living with someone following divorce, then one should refrain from Holy Communion until that situation is rectified. Please, if you feel that you need to either ask questions or get yourself right with the Lord and the Church, feel free to contact me. In some cases, this only takes a few moments.

I firmly believe that God blesses our world with the union of man and woman. This is evident when you see the love of a couple, or the children which they may be given. Let us pray for those who may be having difficulty and let us pray for all married couples, that they will find in their union, Christ who unites them.

On an administrative note: As you know, I am in the process of finishing the new **Reconciliation Room**. This room will be handicap accessible and allow for face to face confession in a more pleasing and inviting atmosphere – better lighting, more space. Of course, the option for behind the screen and anonymity will be maintained also. I will be creating a prayer niche out of the former confessionals, most likely for Christmas and Easter displays.
