All of us can say this with certainty. The forty days of Lent have now passed, and now we celebrate the joy of Easter.

"Then the other disciple also went in, the one who had arrived at the tomb first, and he saw and believed. For they did not yet understand the Scripture that he had to rise from the dead," from today's gospel account.

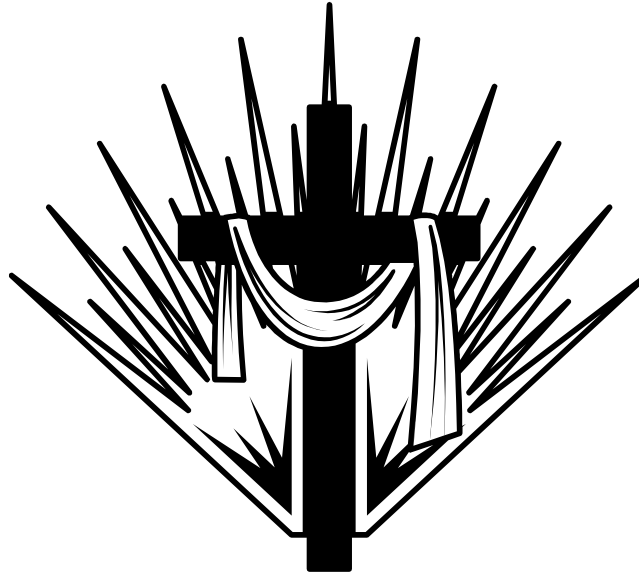
