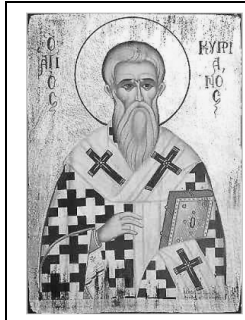

**Saint of the Week**

Saint Cyprian, *bishop and martyr*



Born in the year 190 in Carthage to wealthy pagan parents. Taught rhetoric and literature. Adult convert in 246, taught the faith by Saint Caecilius of Carthage. Ordained in 247. Bishop of Carthage in 249. During the persecution of Decius, beginning in 250, Cyprian lived in hiding, covertly ministering to his flock; his enemies condemned him for being a coward and not standing up for his faith. As a writer he was second only in importance to Tertullian as a Latin Father of the Church. Friend of Saint Pontius. Involved in the great argument over whether apostates should be readmitted to the Church; Cyprian believed they should, but under stringent conditions. Supported Pope Saint Cornelius against the anti-pope Novatian. During the persecutions of Valerian he was exiled to Curubis in 257, brought back Carthage, and then martyred in 258. His name is in the Communicantes in the Canon of the Mass.

St. Cyprian was beheaded on September 14, 258 in Carthage. St. Cyprian is the patron of Algeria and North Africa.

A reflection from the Pastor

"Who do you say that I am;" Jesus in today's gospel. This question asked of Peter was also asked of the people. Jesus was doing more than just taking a poll about his popularity. He was securing the faith of the early Church to be and making certain that those near him were aspiring to that same faith.

In our own time, there are so many that are defined by one group or another. For some, if they don't introduce themselves as a member of a group, then they don't feel valued. But Jesus asks us to look beyond ourselves. The question posed to the group is posed the individual (Peter): Who do **you** say that I am? The same question is posed to us. For some, the answer comes with mixed emotions. One day, Jesus is Lord of their life, but the next, well they'll get back to him later. Still in similar cases, Jesus is a convenient person to have around in tough times, but as long as things are going well, then he's not really important. But the reality of the question from today's gospel, invites us to ask ourselves daily, how much do we look like the Jesus Christ who walked the earth. How much do our lives reflect who we are because of who is: Jesus who saves us from our sins and the Christ; the anointed one who leads us to eternal life.

Sit with that this week. Take a good look at your journey of faith and ask the question "who do I say that Jesus is?" Then let the work of faith, hope, love, and service of the gospel begin, without reservation, and without the need for popularity.

The year celebrating the 50th anniversary of St. Patrick's begins on September 15th, the day St. Patrick's was founded here in Bloomington. In honor of this event, we will have a pot luck supper this Tuesday evening; please bring enough to feed your family/guests to share with others.
