Community Events:

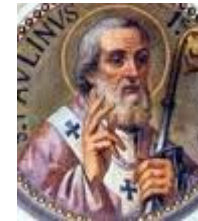

St. Aloysius Gonzaga,
Religious

The son of a high dignitary of the Spanish court, Aloysius (born 1568) at age 16 gave up his hereditary right to be prince of Mantua in Italy. Called to a life of prayer and purity, he was attracted to the Jesuits. Their discipline made him advance remarkably in sanctity. Becoming ill from contagion while helping the sick, Aloysius died at age 23. Canonized a saint in 1726, he was proclaimed "Patron of Youth" by Pope Benedict XIII.



June 22nd,
St. Paulinus of Nola,
Bishop

Paulinus was born at Bordeaux, France, around 353. He was named Roman Consul of the area, acquired vast territories, became very rich, was married and had a child. Desiring a better life he gave away all possessions to the poor and with his wife moved to Nola, near Naples. In 409 the people of Nola elected him Bishop. For 22 years the old consul turned Shepherd governed his people well, helped the miserable ones, encouraged all his people in the face of barbarian invasions. Paulinus died in 431.
