Saints of the Week



October 15th, St. Teresa of Avila, Virgin and Doctor

Today's saint lived during the

century of Spanish exploration of the New World. Born at Avila, Spain (1515), Teresa entered the Carmelites in 1535, made persistent progress in the way of perfection, had mystical revelations. Setting out on the reform of the Order, she endured many difficulties with unconquered spirit. Teresa composed works of the highest doctrines and mystical theology. She died at age 67 (1582) and was named a Doctor or Teacher of the Church in 1970.



October 17th, St. Ignatius of Antioch, Bishop and Martyr

According to tradition, today's

saint was the second after Peter to be Bishop of Antioch. Condemned to the beasts, Ignatius was brought to Rome in Trajan's time and died courageously in 107. On the way to Rome he wrote seven letters to various churches. These give interesting information about Christian life at that time.
