December 31<sup>st</sup>,  
St. Sylvester I,  
Pope

Sylvester became Pope in 314, shortly after the Peace of Constantine. He served the church as Pope for 21 years-one of the longest pontificates during the first Christian millennium. He fought Arianism and saw the Church develop in remarkable fashion. He started the basilicas of St. Peter, St. Paul and St. John Lateran. Pope Sylvester is remembered also because his death occurred on the last day of the year in 335. He helps us end the pilgrimage of each civil year.
