

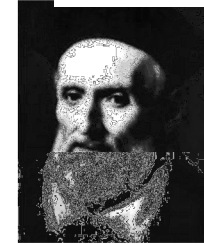

St. Philip Neri,
Priest

Today we honor the "saint of joy"-the delightful Philip Neri gifted with a special sense of humor. Born in Florence in 1515, Philip came to Rome at age 26 and never left the Eternal City. Rome, recently occupied and sacked (1527), was in pitiable condition. Philip visited the sick and imprisoned, taught the children, heard confessions. He founded the Oratorio of Divine Love-the Oratorian priests. Philip delighted in walking to the Seven Basilicas in Rome. He died at 80, was canonized in 1622, and remains an influential force in Rome and throughout the Catholic world.
