Today's humble saint, son of a white Spanish grandee father and a black Panamanian mother, was born in Lima, Peru, in 1579. As a boy he learned the art of healing. Entering the Dominicans, he served as infirmarian and in 1603 took religious vows. Martin healed the illnesses of the poor and also of animals, led a life of prayer, penance, and extraordinary spiritual gifts and died in 1639. A patron saint of American blacks, he was canonized by Pope John XXIII in 1962.

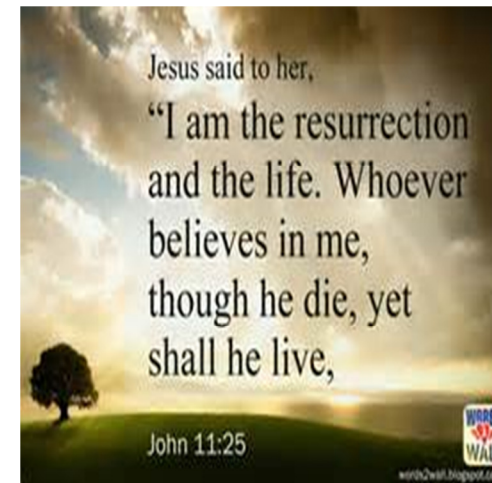
