## Saints of the Week



April 7<sup>th</sup>,  
St. John Baptist De La  
Salle,  
Priest

In the year 1679 this newly-ordained priest began a new educational work. At Rheims in France, his city of birth, John opened a school to educate poor children. The education was not classical, but rather practical and directed towards living as a Christian worker. He opened other schools, and in 1684 founded a religious community, the Brothers of the Christian Schools. His last years were filled with great trials. These he bore in Christ-like silence. He died on today's date, Good Friday in 1619. He was canonized a saint in 1900.
