St. Bernard (1090-1153) dominated the century in which he lived. At age 22 he joined the Cistercian monks. Shortly after made Abbot of Clairvaux, Bernard by words and actions encouraged his monks to outstanding virtue. He influenced Popes and kings, traveled to bring peace and unity preached the Second Crusade. He wrote much and wrote movingly concerning the Lord Jesus, spirituality, the Scriptures and the Blessed Mother. Bernard died on this date in 1153.
