St. Clare,
Virgin

The "little plant of St. Francis," Clare Offreduccio, was born in Assisi. On Palm Sunday of 1212 this 18 year old young woman escaped from her wealthy home and received the religious habit from St. Francis. Clare became the mother and Foundress of the Franciscan Second Order, called the "Poor Clares." After a life of remarkable discipline, holiness and poverty, she died in 1253.



August 13th,
St. Pontian,
Pope & Martyr
St. Hippolytus,
Priest & Martyr

In 230 Pontian became Pope. The Roman Church at that time was divided, with the rigorist priest Hippolytus leading one faction. In 235 Pope and priest were deported into forced labor in Sardinia and there were martyred for their common faith. Their bodies were brought back to Rome, after the persecution, on August 13th.
